

Moderated by the European Institute Foundation and facilitated by Trilateral Research, this CoP serves as an expert platform for dialogue. The CoP Network integrates the needs and interests of different public and private **stakeholders** that play a role in large-scale surveillance of public spaces. Its members include surveillance professionals, law enforcement agencies, local authorities, researchers and academics, NGOs, local communities, and citizens.

To date, the CoP Network has 66 members, affiliated to 20+ organisations, operating

across 8+ member states including Belgium, Bulgaria, Germany, Greece, Ireland,

Netherlands, Portugal, and Austria.
